It aims to provide health care workers with a readily accessible, electronic vehicle for sharing information about research, knowledge, experiences, perceptions and wisdom with colleagues involved in all facets of health informatics and health information technology. eJHI is also the official journal of the Health Informatics Society of Australia (HISA) and the Australian College of Health Informatics (HISA), see <http://ejhi.net> for further details.

Topics

eJHI calls for papers related to the field of Health Informatics and health informatics technology. eJHI aims to publish original, high quality papers related to Health Informatics and health informatics technology in a timely fashion.

Apart from general issues, the journal aims to provide overviews of the state-of-the-art in a certain specialty by publishing special issues on selected topics. The journal has recently published a special issue on Health Data Mining and is currently among others preparing special issues on

- Aged Care Informatics,
- Privacy and Security,
- Semantic Interoperability, and
- the Australian Health Informatics Conference (HIC).

All special issues are guest-edited by experts of the field, and all contributions peer-reviewed by our international Editorial Board and further reviewers. Papers of general issues are edited by Prof. Evelyn Hovenga, the chairperson of the Organising Committee of the next Medinfo conference. Dr. Sebastian Garde is Managing Editor of the journal.
